

### BARDAHL TRIUMPHS AT SAN DIEGO

Miss Bardahl with Ron Musson in her cockpit led a 16-boat field October 3 to win the San Diego Cup Races. Fresh from her Sept. 24 Lake Tahoe triumph, the masterful Miss Bardahl set a record on this Southern California course before some 40,000 spectators, bringing her annual score to within 188 points of the national high point championship. If she makes it before joining the Budweiser camp next year, it will be the boat's

third successive title, Musson's second. In this regatta, Seattle's Green Dragon raised her own 15-mile record to 116.079 mph and topped Miss Exide's single-lap mark in the first heat with a speed of 117.87 mph. She has thus far gone 57 consecutive heats without mechanical failure. In the finale, Bardahl led Exide and Madison, second and third respectively. Such Crust IV came in fourth.
